He was made a Member of the Order of Australia in 1998 in the Military Division for services to the Army.

AUSTRALIND TRAIN TRIP TO BUNBURY. THURSDAY 29TH AUGUST 2013

The time in Bunbury is from 11.55 a.m. to 2.45 p.m. during which time we will enjoy a lunch meal at the

Parade on the Water Hotel



[we will mini-bus from the Bunbury Station/Hotel and return].

Train travel may be **free or discounted** depending on your 'seniors' classification/pension card entitlement:

I. CONCESSIONS

Concessions are available for children under 16 years of age, and residents of Western Australia holding a Pensioner Concession Card, Commonwealth Senior's Health Care Card, WA Seniors Card, Veterans' Affairs Gold card or Student Smart Rider Card. Visitors with a Person with Visual Impairment Travel Pass, Seniors Cardholders from another Australian State or Territory and holders of a VIP Backpacker or YHA Australia Discount Card are also entitled to concessional travel. Travel is free for children under 5 years of age if seated on an adult parent's or carer's lap.

2. Pensioner Concession Card holders

The Australian Government issues, through DVA, a Pensioner Concession Card to eligible persons on service pensions, age pensions, and income support supplement. Holders are eligible for a range of Australian Government concessions. **PCC** holders in WA are also eligible for an annual free trip on

TransWA trains: a concession may be available for the carer of a PCC holder with severe disabilities when travelling on WestRail.

Bookings: Reservations are essential and may be made up to three months in advance by telephoning 1300 662 205 (Australia wide, local call cost) from 8.30am - 5.00pm Monday to Friday, 8.30am - 4.30pm Saturday and 10.00am - 4.00pm Sunday (WST), at Transwa booking centres, accredited ticketing agents (times vary) or online at www.transwa.wa.gov.au. TTY callers may call the National Relay Service on 13 36 77 then quote 1300 662 205.

The fares (as at 1 Jul 13) are: (1) FULL ADULT RETURN - \$61; (2) CONCESSION RETURN: \$30.50 (3.) ELIGIBLE PCC - FREE [You need to provide the concession reference number when making the booking and produce the relevant concession card/voucher when collecting the ticket

Lunch will be at the Parade Hotel on the Water,
Bunbury located at the entrance to the Leschenault
Inlet. You have a choice of a meat or fish meal & salad
plus dessert and tea/coffee. Cost is
\$35 per person and includes drinks. Complete the online booking form emailed to you or the form

Transport to/from the Hotel to the Railway Station will be by mini-bus - each bus load will share the cost [approximately \$14 each way
