WESTERN AUSTRALIAN WAR MEMORIALS 4TH BATTALION ACCIDENT MEMORIAL, MOORA

On 15 March 1943, 14 Soldiers from the 4TH Battalion were killed while examining a mortar bomb that exploded. The Memorial is located near the site of the tragedy at Moora.
