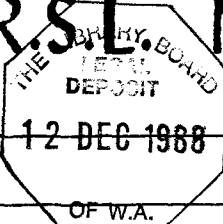

### THE GUEST SPEAKER

Alex Main's first career was as an experimental psychophysiologicalist. During the 1960's he worked in the field of Art Therapy and then in the measurement of deafness. He published

a training guide for the hearing aid industry and created an international exhibition on Expressionism before accepting a teaching post in psychology at the University of Strathclyde in Scotland. After a short time as a teacher, he moved into the field of academic staff development and was for 15 years Adviser on Educational Methods at the University of Strathclyde. During this time he was seconded as Co-ordinating Officer for the training of University Teachers for the whole of the United Kingdom, and as Visiting Professor in Ontario. He has also been Educational Adviser to the Metropolitan Police, and has been a consultant to various national and international organisations in Africa, Asia and Europe.

His publications include "Encouraging Effective Learning" (Scottish Academic Press 1980) and "Educational Staff Development" (Croom Helm 1985). Since December 1986 he has been Director of the Educational Services and Teaching Resources Unit at Murdoch University.
