

CORRESPONDENCE

In the regular Highgate luncheon meetings we never really have time to discuss some of the matters which perhaps could have our consideration.

When we have a guest speaker waiting and everyone is keen to get on with the luncheon it is hardly an appropriate time to start debating weighty matters.

It seems to me that since we have a considerable amount of experience and expertise among the members of Highgate we ought to be giving a bit of a push to Headquarters from time to time and be prodding them.

What prompts me at the moment is the subject of the Government deciding to permit the Russian trawlers to use our Ports and Aeroflot to fly the crews in.

It is a great coincidence that the Russians have suddenly become interested in W.A. since the announcement that there will be several submarines and frigates based at Garden Island and that we have a new satellite communications base at Geraldton.

One can imagine Aeroflot flying down the coast, over the Exmouth base, over the Geraldton station and over the Garden Island base, with their eyes wide open and ears flapping.

At the same time no one, certainly not the media, has mentioned the fact that in March 1988 the Russians cancelled an Australian Trade Exhibition scheduled that month in Vladivostok; the reason was that Vladivostok was a Naval Base and it would be too sensitive to let the Australians in there.

I do not recall League Headquarters saying one word about the trawler deal and it is this sort of situation that prompts me to suggest that Highgate should perhaps be giving them a prod from time to time.

Rather than delay the usual luncheon programme by raising the subject there I thought I might write and voice my thoughts and my concern.

I know that the Russians have a satellite overhead which can watch in true 'big brother' style but there is still a great advantage in having people on the ground and in place in the local community.
