

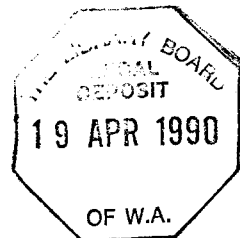

September 23, 1919 - March 1, 1990

Cam served with the RAAF 1940-1949, mainly flying Beaufighters in the Pacific area. He was awarded the A.E. (Airman's Efficiency). He married Middy in 1948, and they first registered the Business Name of 'Ad Astra Dry Cleaners' in September 1949 and commenced business in December 1949.

Cam was a Sub Warden (State War Memorial) and a Past President of the Highgate Sub Branch of the R.S.L. and also a member of the Air Force Association, Air Crew Association, RAF Club, London, and the Masonic Lodge.

He was involved in numerous other activities including being Past State and Past Federal President of the Dry Cleaning Institute of Australia, Regional Vice President, Vice President of the International Dry Cleaners Congress for 12 years, International President 1986/87.

He was a member of the Board of Governors of St Mary's Anglican Girls' School, Karrinyup, for 23 years.

Member of the Board of the Confederation of West Australian Industry, Past Vice President and Committee Member, Subiaco Football Club (1960's), Vestry of St Mary's, West Perth (1950's).
