Dr Jim Gill was born in Western Australia and gained a First Class Honours degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Western Australia in 1968. He obtained his Doctor of Philosophy degree from Cambridge University for pioneering work in computer-aided design.

During 14 years with the Main Roads Department Dr Gill worked in a number of roles, from advanced pre-stressed concrete bridge design to senior management. From 1980 to 1982 he was the Department's Divisional Engineer, Kalgoorlie.

In 1982/83 Dr Gill completed a Management degree at Harvard University, USA.

Dr Gill joined Westrail in March 1987 and was appointed Commissioner in June 1988.

Dr Gill holds fellowships of the Institution of Engineers Australia, the Australian Institute of Management and the Chartered Institute of Transport. He was a Commissioner of the WA Post Secondary Education Commission and a member of the Minister of Education's recent Review of Higher Education. Dr Gill is a member of the Board of the Graduate School of Management and the Engineering Foundation at the University of Western Australia.
