JOHN CHAPPELL

On the 9th January, we farewelled one of our most respected members of Highgate Sub-Branch, John Chappell, who passed away on the 5th January, at Hollywood Hospital, at the age of 92.

John arrived in Western Australia in 1912. He was employed as a Law Clerk with Haynes, Robinson & Cox until his enlistment in the A.I.F. in 1914, serving with the 3rd Brigade Headquarters in France. On return from active service, he joined the staff of the legal firm, Nicholson & Hensman. He was also employed as Accountant and Secretary of several Mercantile Companies in Perth, and was closely associated with the Master Printers' Association as Secretary and Organizer.

As a serving Officer in the 16th Battalion, the Cameron Highlanders of W.A., he was called up for service at the outbreak of war in 1939. After five years' service he was discharged at Lt. Col. Following his war service he was a prominent member of the R.S.L. and was appointed State Secretary in 1947. For his service to the R.S.L. he was made a Life Member. His other activities included: Past President of Perth Legacy Club; Past President Press SubBranch R.S.L.; President of the St Andrew's Society; Patron of the Caledonian Pipe Band; Patron of the 16th Battalion Cameron Highlanders' Association; President of Highgate Sub-Branch R.S.L., and member of the Justices Association. John was also honoured as a Member of the British Empire.

He is well known to those of us with close associations with 16th Battalion the Cameron Highlanders as one of the prominent figures in the formation of the Battalion in 1936. He was Secretary of the Founding Committee prior to joining the Battalion on its inception. John maintained that close association with the Battalion until his death. His dedicated contribution to the Cameron Association and the other organizations that he served so loyally over many years will be sadly missed.

To Donald, Bruce, David, Ross and all the family, we extend our deepest sympathy on the loss of their Father. To our members, we mourn the loss of a great friend. To sum up the life of John Chappell, these words of Robert Burns', I feel, do justice to a great life:-

AN HONEST MAN LIES HERE AT REST
AS EVER GOD WITH HIS IMAGE BLESSED;
THE FRIEND OF MAN, THE FRIEND OF TRUTH,
THE FRIEND OF AGE, AND GUIDE OF YOUTH;
FEW HEARTS LIKE THIS - WITH VIRTUE WARMED,
FEW HEADS WITH KNOWLEDGE SO INFORMED;
IF THERE'S ANOTHER WORLD, HE LIVES IN BLISS;
IF THERE IS NONE, HE MADE THE BEST OF THIS.
