Dr Neil Cumpston.FRACP. SPEAKER:

Dr. Cumpston will speak primarily of the Specialist Medical SUBJECT: Services for Veterans within Australia. If time permits some of the newer advances in interventional cardiology will be incorporated into the speech.

Di. Cumpston is a Cardiologist, first appointed to the Royal Perth Hospital as a Consultant in 1968 and has continued to be a Senior Cardiologist at that Institution since that time.
