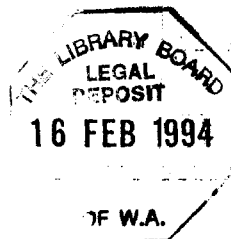

RETURNED & SERVICES LEAGUE OF W.A. HIGHGATE SUB-BRANCHNOTES ON FINANCIAL STATEMENTS DATED 31ST DECEMBER 1993

Accumulated Funds - decreased by \$665 during 1993. Surpluses in the Welfare Account (\$786) and the Honour Avenue Account (\$245) were offset by a deficiency in the General Account (\$1696) The main reason for this decline was our contribution of \$2000 made to the War Veterans' Home Building Appeal.

Invested Funds - now stand at \$2000. The outstanding amount due to us by the Permanent Building Society has been written off thus contributing further to the decline in our funds. It is possible that we will receive a small (final) dividend of between 2c & 6c some time during 1994.

Interest Received - substantially down, from \$393 to \$272. This reflects the loss of interest on the P.B.S. deposit, and recent reductions in interest rates generally.

Functions - as usual the Anzac Day Breakfast broke even. A small profit was made on the Ladies' Luncheon and the Ladies' Night.

Newsletter - costs exceeded subscriptions by \$442.

Poppy Day - gross proceeds were \$3071 - down \$931 on last year's total, due largely to a shortage of volunteer collectors.

Donations - up \$449 in 1993. A very encouraging trend.

Luncheons - one only shortfall, of \$19-50, was recorded.

Welfare Account-this fund increased by \$786, compared with last year's figure of \$1467 - down \$681. This was due mainly to much lower returns from Poppy Day Sales.

Honour Avenue - has moved from a deficiency of \$324 to a surplus of \$245. Some of 1992's "one-off" expenditures were not repeated and there was an increase in the amount of contributions
