HIS ACCOUNT OF THE BATTLE WITH THE ITALIAN CRUISERS "BARTOLEMEO CALLEONI" AND "BANDE NERE" WAS SO REALISTIC THAT ONE COULD ALMOST SMELL THE CORDITE AND HEAR THE CRASH OF GUNFIRE AS THE SIX INCH GUNS OF THESE WELL ARMED GREYHOUNDS OF THE SEA FLUNG SCREAMING METAL AT EACH OTHER ACROSS THE WATER. THE RESULT IS OF COURSE HISTORY.
