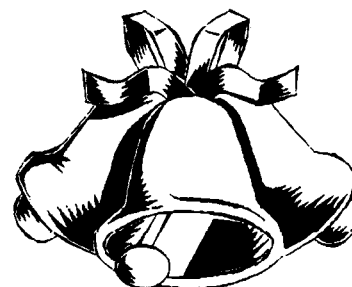
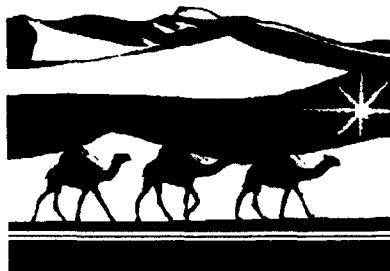

### **PENSIONER CONCESSION CARD (CONTINUED):**

### **FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS DUTY (FID):**

PCC card holders who have their pensions directly credited to their accounts are exempt from paying the duty on these pension payments. Any other deposits made are subject to the duty.

### **LEGAL AID:**

Provides low cost initial advice and assistance to those in need of it throughout WA. The services provided include: Legal Aid Bureau, Information Line; and Duty Lawyer Services at Court.

A public information centre in the Perth office holds community information brochures and materials about legal problems and related issues. Legal Aid procedures and issues brochure and kits.

### **RECREATIONAL FISHING LICENCES:**
