DID YOU KNOW?

It remains an historic oddity that the first two ceremonies at the **State War Memorial** were conducted by the Japanese and the Italians (both before it was dedicated on 24 November 1929). On Sunday 17 June 1928, Vice Admiral Kobayashi, CO Japanese Training Squadron laid a wreath. The Japanese Navy also participated in a ceremony on 14 April 1935.

On Tuesday 1 October 1929 Italian Consul Citarelli laid a wreath. He also laid a wreath on 8 November 1931, as did Italian Navy Captain Jachino on 10 October 1935. Captain Adelis, French Navy, followed the latter on 17 October 1935.

Other prominent persons listed in participating in ceremonies prior to WWII were Amy Johnson, Douglas Jardine, the Wallabies, The Duke of Gloucester, Group Settlement children, The Grenadier Guards and French Boy Scouts. (Thanks to Helen Birch for undertaking this research.)

RSLWA's largest annual fundraising event for the year is the Poppy Appeal. Created in 1921, this is our longest-running fundraiser as well.
